Join us for Mass! 7:00 AM in Manley or 6:30 PM in Elmwood

The Church recognizes this day as a solemn day of abstinence from meat (for ages 14+) and fasting (for ages 18–59), where faithful receive blessed palm ashes on their forehead as a symbol of mortality and penance. Fasting days mean eating only one full meal and two smaller (which together do not equal the one meal). The sick, pregnant/nursing women, or those with manual labor jobs are exempt from fasting. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are fasting days, and all Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence from meat.
